Annual Report for the year ending 10th April 2016.

Willingham British School Trust is a registered charity which awards educational grants to benefit the youth of the village through individual or institutional applications.

The Trust is pleased to report another busy and successful year. Reports of the Trust's meetings and dates of meetings of the Trustees are now placed in the Willingham News. This has encouraged interest in the Trust's activities.

Support for Willingham Primary School and Cottenham Village College has continued to be an important priority for the Trust. The Primary School has requested and received funding support for an assessment package for science, non-fiction library resources, resources appropriate for pupils with special needs and a set of Lion's Bibles. Cottenham Village College received grants for the purchase of sets of textbooks to be used in three GCSE courses (History, Geography and Religion, Philosophy and Ethics).

The Trust has also supported the purchase of items of media equipment by Willingham Baptist Church and the Bubbles Children's Group at St Mary and All Saints Church. Willingham Youth Trust received funding to purchase board games, arts and craft resources and a games console.

Individual grants have been given to support the costs of University undergraduate programmes for a range of subjects including Sociology, Computer Science, Motorsport Engineering, Chemistry, Psychology and Politics. Two travel grants to support 'gap year' activities have also been made.

The Trust has received no applications to support further education studies or apprenticeships during the past year.

School and individual budgets have become progressively tighter in recent years and demands upon the Trust's funds greater. The Trustees will continue to provide positive support in the future for educational activity which will help to enrich and support the life of young people from Willingham.


