## Halls Report for Willingham Parish Council, March 2015

## Ploughman Hall.

## The following can be reported:

- Minor works have been required in the Ploughman Hall. Firstly, an interior door handle had to be re-attached to the door and the external catch for the main door adjusted. This work was completed by Nick Flower, costing £35.00 (invoice attached). Secondly, a leak in the toilets required repair. This was completed by ACA Heating & Plumbing at a cost of £88.60 (excluding VAT) (invoice attached).
- 2. It was reported last month that three items in the Ploughman Hall electrical system required replacement. Two quotations for the replacement of the two heaters are now available: GM Pake & Sons is quoting £96.45 per heater whilst Clive Bass Electrical is quoting £167.00 per heater (these are both attached). The situation with respect to the heating element for the small kitchen water heater is more complicated as it has now been established that this heater is not connected to the mains supply. Supplementary quotations for this item are being sought and will be brought forward to the May Parish Council meeting.
- 3. At the time of preparing this report the following activity is ongoing:
  - Quotations have been sought for the placing of bollards around two areas of the car park, prior to a planting scheme being adopted (see attached diagram).
  - ii) A quotation has been sought from Aztec Services for an additional security light to be fitted in the area adjacent to the Youth Club entrance.

#### Public Hall.

- 1. There has been no work required in the Public Hall.
- 2. Clarification was sought by Councillors last month with respect to the costing of the electricity supply. The Minutes noted that four bills had been settled. These were as follows: a credit of £86.56 for 15/07/2014 26/08/2014, two payments of £76.81 for the period 28/10/2014 03/01/2015 and £71.97 for the period 27/08/2014 27/10/2014 and a fourth payment of £32.54 for the period 04/01/2015 03/02/2015. The Public Hall Users Committee have been invoiced for this fourth bill under the terms of the new leasing agreement.

#### The Youth Club.
