Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 30 August 2012 at 7 30 pm in the Parish Office, Ploughman Hall, West Fen Road

1. Apologies for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor Purnell.

The meeting was adjourned.

Mrs Chadwick of 176 Station Road attended with a friend. She was concerned that the Parish Council's response to S/1264/12/RM was not accurate in that it had noted previous development at both 176 and 178 Station Road. Mrs Chadwick stated that there had been no development at 176 and that all the development had taken place at 178. Mrs Chadwick went on to explain an ongoing dispute with her neighbour over the boundary line. It was stated that this was not a matter that the Parish Council or even the District Council controlled and that legal action would need to take its course. The Parish Council did however agree that the matter would be formally recorded with a copy of the minute sent to SCDC.

- The visual impact on a flat landscape
- The intrusion into countryside
- The proximity to existing caravan dwellings with limited sound insulation
- The seemingly optimistic claims for efficiency of about thirty percent
- The establishment of precedent for future expansion
