Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 27 February 2013 at 7 30 pm in the Parish Office, Ploughman Hall, West Fen Road

1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor King

Two residents from Short Lane attended the meeting and expressed concerns over the development on Green Street. The building has now started and it has been brought to their attention that all the properties are now intended for social/affordable housing. They had not been notified of this change of use and were concerned about the possible impact this may have. The Parish Council confirmed that they had not been notified of any change either and would contact SCDC to seek clarification.

 - (i) S/0196/13/FL 83 Rampton Road, Willingham, Dr Richard Parker Rear Extension

Councillor Cook proposed that the Parish Council recommend approval. This was seconded by Councillor Harris and agreed unanimously.

(ii) S/0227/13/FL - 4 Conference Close, Willingham, Mr M Jakes - single storey rear extension

Councillor Law proposed that the Parish Council recommend approval. This was seconded by Councillor Cook and agreed unanimously.

(iii) S/0241/13/FL – Kerley & Co, Over Road, Willingham, Mr T Kerley – erection of building to serve as a reception & meeting area, office space and welfare facilities.

Councillor Cook proposed that the Parish Council recommend refusal. There is a huge disparity between the various documentation submitted. The plans appear to show new access but the statement doesn't. The access statement refers to 49 Station Road Over ad not Willingham Road, Over. The Parish Council would ask that this application is resubmitted correctly and clearly. This was seconded by Councillor Harris and agreed with four votes in favour and one abstention.
