Councillor Cook proposed the minutes be accepted as a true record of the meeting, seconded by Councillor Croucher and **agreed** with seven votes in favour and one abstention due to not being at the meeting.

- 6. Planning Applications for consideration
 - (i) S/3020/15/AD Willingham House, 50 Church Street, Willingham, Cambridge Melchior College projecting signs.

Councillor Cook proposed the Council recommend approval, seconded by Councillor Slater and agreed unanimously.

(ii) S/2966/15/OL – Alwyn Tourist Park, Willingham Road, Over, Mr P Pickering – erection of two bungalows to replace two existing mobile homes.

Councillor Cook proposed the Council make no recommendation as it appears to make relatively minor change to the site and is outside the parish boundary, seconded by Councillor Watson and agreed unanimously.

(iii) S/2797/15/FL – 10 Berrycroft, Willingham, Mr and Mrs Julian – demolition of existing dwelling and erection of 2 x detached dwellings with new access via Berrycroft.

This application had been resubmitted for consideration due to an admin error by SCDC. Councillor Law proposed the Council recommend REFUSAL due to the gross overdevelopment of the site and with no parking for one of the proposed properties which would be in very close proximity to the bend and neighbouring busy businesses. Seconded by Councillor Watson and agreed unanimously.

(iv) S/3203/15/FL – 32 Newington, Willingham, Mr J Window – single storey rear orangery style extension.

Councillor Slater proposed the Council recommend approval, seconded by Councillor Harris and agreed unanimously.

 (v) S/2921/15/OL – Land South of 1b Over Road, Willingham, Mr E Wynn – outline proposal for erection of 26 dwellings including 10 affordable units & ancillary access arrangements (all matters reserved apart from access)

Councillor Manning proposed the Council make no recommendation but request for a thorough review by highways given existing issues with parking on Over Road, the approval of another development of 12 dwellings within fifty metres, the proximity of traffic lights at a junction onto the B1050 and current congestion problems, seconded by Councillor Cook and agreed unanimously.
