Dear Councillors and Residents,

Since the 26th of April 2016 to present date, Cambridgeshire Constabulary have had 222 crimes reported by residents and local businesses that reside within Willingham. Figures show both June and July 2016 to be our busiest period for crime with a total of 64 crimes being reported to us.

A comparison of ASB, incidents and crimes which have occurred within Willingham vs the whole of South Cambridgeshire.

Amongst others Willingham was recently identified as a village which experiences marginally higher criminal activity. Towards the end of last year Church Street was chosen as a 'Micro Beat'. This particular area was recognised for needing more police presence and 3 objectives were set in an attempt to decrease crime. These objectives were;

- Targeted High Vis patrols.
- Identify a Neighbourhood Watch street coordinator.
- Organise a crime prevention surgery.

2 objectives have been completed and 1 is still ongoing. The crime prevention event took place on the 21/01/2017, a total of 16 residents attended. Mike Tidball is now the street coordinator for Church Street and Brian Reynolds has taken over as village coordinator. Patrols are still ongoing and are likely to continue for the foreseeable future.
