# 1. To receive apologies for absence

Apologies were received and ratified from Councillor McKee due to a personal commitment.

# 4. To approve the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 10th October 2022

Councillor Law proposed the minutes be accepted as a true record of the meeting, seconded by Councillor Rogers, and **ratified** with three votes in favour and two abstentions due to not being at the meeting.

5. To deal with any matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022, not covered elsewhere on this agenda.

None raised.

#### 6. Planning Applications for consideration

- (i) 22/04096/HFUL 4 Berrycroft, Willingham, Mr Gowler two storey extension to the rear. Councillor Harris raised a query regarding the wall that would be built against, and the parishioners present confirmed that it would be assessed by a structural engineer and if needed would either be steel framed or rebuilt. Councillor Law proposed the Council support the application, seconded by Councillor Todd, and **ratified** unanimously.
- (ii) 22/04109/HFUL Dogrose Barn, Green Street, Willingham, RCG Ltd entrance gates to front and detached single storey storage building to rear.

Councillor Todd proposed that the Council make no recommendation but would ask that South Cambridgeshire District Council clarify as to whether previous unauthorised development on the site had been removed. Seconded by Councillor Law and **ratified** unanimously.

(iii) 22/03980/FUL – 130 Rampton Road, Willingham, Mr Webster – erection of a detached double garage.

Councillor Harris proposed the Council make no recommendation, seconded by Councillor Rogers, and **ratified** unanimously.

## floodlit multi use games area.

As this application had been submitted by the Council, no comments or recommendations were made.

(v) 22/04011/FUL – The Bungalow, Haden Way, Willingham, Mr Rooney – replacement dwelling following demolition of existing.

Councillor Harris proposed the Council object to the application for the following reasons, seconded by Councillor Watson and **ratified** unanimously.

- The application is to replace a building that is no longer required as the existing bungalow was provided for an agricultural worker for the Piggery in 1975 with an agricultural tie. The Piggery has been removed and hence the housing provision is no longer required.
- Following a previous application in 2017 for a bungalow on the Piggery site, which was refused following appeal, the applicant was given permission for a traveller pitch, including utility building. Given the approved use of the land, the Council do not feel that a permanent residence is either needed or appropriate.
- The Council would also reiterate concerns it has raised with enforcement that the applicant has already breached the existing planning consents for the site.

If the officer is minded to approve the application, the Council request that it is passed to the committee for consideration.
