IMPORTANT HIGHWAY INFORMATION

Dear Resident/Occupier

Greener, safer, and better-quality journeys

Upcoming Highways works – Over Road drainage

We are conducting essential work in your area to complete drainage works to improve the drainage system along Over Road and trim vegetation in the outfalls from Monday 3rd March 2025 to Friday 28th March 2025 from 09:30hrs and 16:00hrs for Cambridgeshire County Councils works. To aid with your planning, we are providing more details below. Please note that the **roads will be closed during this work.**

Where will we be working?

We will be working from the start of Over Road near Haden Way to the junction of High Street and Berry Croft.

Why do these works?

Failure to undertake these works poses a greater risk of surface water flooding in the area. One of the problem areas highlighted is the ongoing surface water drainage issues that result in extensive standing water near the Desire Smith Bungalows, creating a flooding risk for adjoining properties.

When will the work take place?

Although our works are happening Monday 3rd March 2025 to Friday 28th March 2025 from 09:30hrs and 16:00hrs (limited to working days only) for the Cambridgeshire County Councils works. Snowdon Homes require up to a 2-week closure 24/7. This means the road will be closed 24/7 for up to two weeks starting 3rd March 2025. subject to their road space approval.

Will the road be closed?

The work will be carried out under a **full road closure**. This helps us do the work quickly and efficiently, while keeping residents, road users and the workforce safe.

What does this mean for you?



- You will always have access to your property if it is safe to do so.
- There may be delay when accessing your property, to allow the on-site team to move plant or machinery out of the way. This will help you move safely through the working areas. Thank you for your patience while they do this.
- We may ask you to enter the worksite from the other end of the closure, depending on where we are working. This is to keep you and our workforce safe.
- You may need to use the diversion route, which we have attached overleaf for your reference. This also shows the area of works. Thank you for your understanding.
- The work may generate some noise. We apologise in advance for this. Where practical, we will do any particularly noisy work at the beginning of the shift. We want to minimise disturbance (while understanding that everyone's routine is different).

Will the schedule change?

We will make every effort to deliver the work in the scheduled period. Sometimes the work is weather dependent or affected by issues outside of our control. This means we may need to reschedule at short notice. We will endeavour to overcome any challenges and notify you where possible of any changes. We will be keeping the parish informed of changes and they will be able to share relevant information themselves.
