CEMETERY FEES April 2025

1. Persons resident in the Parish of Willingham

These fees apply when the person to be interred was a resident of Willingham either:

- Immediately before his/her death: or
- When the exclusive right of burial was purchased, if at an earlier date: or
- Until she/he left the parish for care in his/her declining years: or
- In the case of a still-born child, if either or both parents are residents at the time of interment.

<u>Exclusive Right of Burial</u> Purchase of exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave 7 feet by 3 feet for a term of 99 years from the date of burial (not payable if the deceased qualifies under the Childrens Funeral Fund (CFF)	£ 200.00
Purchase of exclusive right of burial of ashes in a plot 18 inches square for a term of 99 years from the date of burial (not payable if the deceased qualifies under the Childrens Funeral Fund (CFF)	£ 100.00
(Only one fee for exclusive right of burial need be paid, even if there is more than one burial in an earthen grave or ashes plot)	
<u>Interments</u> For burial of a person under 18 years of age (including stillborn) (not payable if the deceased qualifies under the Childrens Funeral Fund (CFF)	£ 46.00
For burial of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 18 years	£ 200.00
Cremated remains (any age) (per person) (not payable if the deceased qualifies under the Childrens Funeral Fund (CFF)	£ 100.00

Requests for residential cemetery fees for people living on the periphery of the parish will be at the discretion of any two of the Lead councillor for Cemeteries, the Deputy Lead Councillor for Cemeteries, the Parish Council Chairman and the Parish Council Vice Chairman.

2. Non- Residents of Willingham

Non-Residents of Willingham will no longer be allowed to be buried in the Cemetery with the exception of pre-purchased plots. (N.B. Plots can no longer be pre-purchased).

3. Monuments, gravestones, tables and memorial inscriptions

For the right to erect or place an appropriate memorial on a grave in respect of which an exclusive right of burial has been granted (see memorial regulations for memorials permitted in Willingham Cemetery):-

A headstone not exceeding 3 feet in height	£ 100.00
Tablet to Commemorate cremated remains 18 inches square	£ 55.00
Renewal Only of kerb stones or border stones enclosing a space not Exceeding 7ft 6 inches by 3ft 6 inches	£ 100.00
Renewal Only of a headstone exceeding 3 feet in height	£ 150.00
Renewal Only of a monument not exceeding 8 feet in height and occupying A space not exceeding 7ft 6 inches by 3ft 6 inches	£ 888.00
Renewal Only of a monument exceeding that height or occupying a space Exceeding either or both of those dimensions	£ 1110.00
Memorial fees above include the first inscription For Each additional inscription the fee payable is	£ 50.00

NOTE: the above fees are not payable if the deceased qualifies under the Childrens Funeral Fund (CFF)

4. Additional Fees

Transfer of Burial Rights administration£ 50.00
