NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Fen End, Willingham as lies between number 31 and Tempus Court.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this order.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Fen End; B1050; Church Street; Rockmill End; Wilford Furlong and vice versa.

The Order is made to facilitate vegetation removal and associated works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 21 August 2025 and continue until these works have finished or on the 20 February 2027 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 09:00hrs and 16:00hrs 21 August 2025.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
