Footpath Between Wilford Furlong And Brickhills, Willingham

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE)

ORDER 2025-1550

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council intends to make an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any pedestrian from proceeding along Footpath Between Wilford Furlong And Brickhills, Willingham as lies between numbers 56 and 52.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this order.

The alternative route for pedestrians will be as signed.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate gas connection and associated works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 1 September 2025 and continue until these works have finished or on the 28 February 2026 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 1 September 2025 and 3 September 2025.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
